



The City of Orlando District 1 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL32.

Municipal precinct OL32 approximately extends north along Beachline Expressway (State Road 528), east along Narcoossee Road, south along State Road 417, and west along Boggy Creek Road and Canal Road. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

The polling place for OL32 is located at Orlando Fire Station 16, 12375 Lake Nona Gateway Rd.

Orlando Fire Station 16 is situated between Lake Nona Blvd and Lake Nona Gateway Rd in precinct OL32.

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
